The Best of Both Worlds - Felix McDonald

A good income, retirement security, opportunities for education, and plenty of time off to follow the traditional lifestyle in northern Saskatchewan is an attractive combination for any employee, and one that 43-year-old Felix McDonald has been able to take full advantage of at Cameco.

Felix works a seven-in, seven-out schedule at Cameco's Rabbit Lake operation. With every other week off, and four weeks of holidays a year, he enjoys a flexible schedule and makes a good living too.

Felix was born and raised in Fond du Lac, on the north shore of Lake Athabasca, and chose to raise his family there rather than move south like many of his friends. His wife Bertha is from the community and his daughter Pelagie and sons Gerald and Deano all grew up there.

In his teenage years Felix spent two years as a commercial fisherman, and took the opportunity to learn trapping from family elders. He retains these skills today. He also worked as a carpenter on housing construction for the Fond du Lac Band.

In 1983, at the age of 17, he signed on as a labourer with a contractor at Rabbit Lake. Four weeks later, when the contractor found out his age, Felix found himself back in

Fond du Lac working on housing. By law, no one under 18 can work at uranium mine sites.

As soon as he turned 18 he rejoined the contractor as a labourer and carpenter, and later as an apprentice industrial painter. Two years later the contract job was done, and it was back to housing construction for four months.

By then, Rabbit Lake had started to feel like home.

In the fall of 1985, Felix applied for a mill operator trainee position, and was hired the next day. In those days, the



13 circuits in the mill were all managed manually. Felix was soon able to handle them all. Some of the circuits now require separate certification, and are no longer handled by mill operators, while mill circuits are automated and monitored by computer.

"It's still good to know how everything works - it helps me when I'm running the mill," he says. Now a senior mill operator, Felix can operate the mill and manage a crew if called on to do so.

In spite of setbacks, he persevered to get to where he is today. "I just wanted to progress and improve, make a good life for my family and build for a good retirement," he says.

Felix will be eligible for retirement in another eight years, and may take that option.

"I've worked up to where my salary level is higher than some supervisors and I have a lifestyle that is the envy of many people. I live in the most beautiful part of the country where I can hunt, fish and trap right on my doorstep - what more can I ask?" he says.

He would still like the opportunity to be a supervisor, and is working to improve his education through Cameco's Workplace Education program, through which the company donates matching time for educational improvements.

"In the pre-test, I did better than the average high school student, and it's just a matter of getting that piece of paper," he says.

At home, Felix is an accomplished handyman, tackling carpentry, plumbing, electrical or concrete work with equal skill. His house in Fond du Lac would rival any well-built home anywhere, and he has spent a lot of hard-earned money renovating and improving it.

Felix serves his community by acting as their representative on the Northern Saskatchewan Environmental Quality Committee (NSEQC). This committee watches the uranium industry closely, visiting different minesites and meeting regularly for updates on new developments, which representatives pass on to their communities. In the Athabasca

Basin, this involves a dozen or more meetings a year. Cameco cooperates by allowing him time off work, if possible, when meetings fall during his work week.

"I plan to continue on the NSEQC for as long as my community appoints me," he says.

He served nine months on band council in 1995, and may consider entering local politics again – but not until after he retires.

Felix McDonald is proud of his family, his home, his lifestyle and his accomplishments. Fluent in Dené and English, he is a great example of how to mesh two worlds – the traditional and the industrial.
