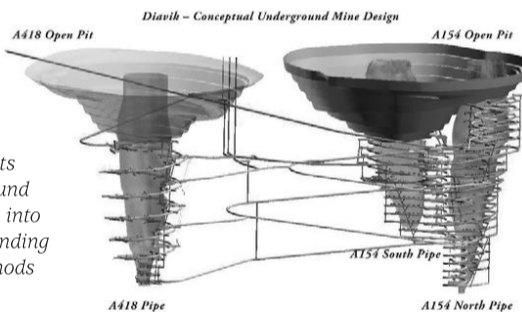

A year-and-a-half of ground and aerial surveying and a battery of other testing and exploration processes in the region may reveal a 100-million year old secret -- whether there are diamonds here.

Saskatoon-based White Fox Resources has been conducting extensive testing around Ituna and was expected to start drilling to determine whether the underground formations resulting from volcanic activity in pre-historic times could yield a mother lode of one of the world's most expensive and most sought-after minerals.

Mike Hartley, head geophysicist with White Fox, says the formations in the area are very similar to formations found around the Prince Albert area, formations that have yielded economically feasible quantities of diamonds.

Shore Gold Inc. owns the Star Diamond project about 60 kilometres east of Prince. The Fort a la Corne area, says Shore Gold, boasts one of the most extensive kimberlite fields in the world. Of the more than 70 kimberlites in the area, more than 70 per cent of them contain diamonds.

The kimberlite averages 88 metres in thickness, says Shore Gold, and covers an area of more than four square kilometres with the formation about 90 metres below the surface. Shore completed an airborne geophysical survey in 1996 followed by ground magnetic surveys. Subsequent drilling and sampling methods indicated a 45,000 tonne bulk sample of material yielded 7,500 carats of diamonds. Shore Gold says each carat averaged \$135 in value.

"It's drawing comparisons, the greater Ituna area, to the Fort

a la Corne diamond fields near Prince Albert," Hartley told The Advance.

"You can draw some parallels and it looks like a very interesting area," says Hartley who's been involved in exploration for more than a year.

What's piqued White Fox's interest are the formations of kimberlite which are associated with diamonds.

"(Diamonds) are brought to the surface in what is known as kimberlite which is basically a volcano. These volcanoes would be (roughly) 100 million years old. If you look at regional geo-physics and structures that have been identified...all I can say is there are parallels.

"There are interesting things that make the area look very much like it could (yield) 'Saskatchewan' diamonds. Diamonds in Saskatchewan are very different than what you could find elsewhere in the world, especially with what's known as Africa diamonds."

"They're very different (geophysically) so we're drawing a lot of conclusions from what is found around (Prince Albert)."

The major difference between 'African' and 'Saskatchewan' diamonds isn't the actual gems themselves but the host material, the kimberlite, explains Hartley. In Africa, when the kimberlite flowed toward the surface, there followed much erosion of that kimberlite which scattered the diamonds relatively close to the surface. That resulted in diamonds easily recovered in riverbeds and channels, Hartley says.

"What happened here in Saskatchewan is that kimberlite were erupting into a shallow sea and this shallow sea then deposited sediments quickly over the top of it so we're left with a large amount of material...We're looking at a formation that's about 100 million years old and in Ituna that makes it about 350 metres down (below ground surface)."

Although White Fox has had up to five employees surveying the area, no actual drilling has been done but "there will be drilling, absolutely..."

While Hartley says he wouldn't want to "disappoint" people if further testing proves negative -- and cautions that 'nothing has been proved' -- preliminary indications of kimberlite have him optimistic.

"I was able to spend quite a bit of time and analyze a lot of the data, a year and a half, and we're able to model the data and it looks very good. It looks very much like a kimberlite...But the proof is in the pudding."

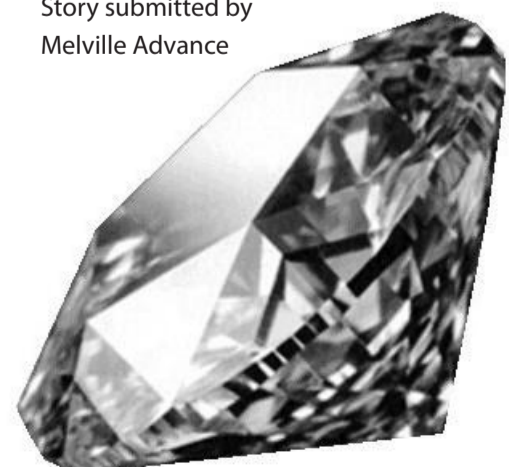

Ituna town councilor Lawrence Korchinsky admits when he heard of the possibility of diamonds in the Ituna area he was skeptical, but he's become more encouraged as he learns of the extent of White Fox's work in the area.

"We're sort of excited but we sort of guarded as well. There's a long way to go on this...Hopefully this thing will come around and we will have more exploration. We all know what happens when you get a mining operation in your community. You have jobs and everything else that comes with it."

Saskatchewan is on a roll economically and natural resources play an enormous part of that, Korchinsky points out, and if a viable diamond deposit is found in the area, then maybe Ituna can play a role in adding to that prosperity, Korchinsky concludes.
