Independent power systems part of new energy mix

When Rolf and Gundel Heckmann

discovered, fell in love with and moved to the Saskatchewan grasslands in 2000, they had an unusual interest in the area. Like most visitors, they enjoyed the local people and natural surrounding, but they also knew southern Saskatchewan is one of the sunniest places in North America.

The Heckmanns saw the area as an ideal place to create a demonstration site for renewable energy. They installed an 8 kW independent solar and wind power system on their rural property that affords them all the conveniences of a modern lifestyle, without the power bills.

Their site near Val Marie is also home to their renewable energy business, Truwest Solar, which they expect to achieve worldwide sales of \$1 million in 2007. Truwest is among a wave of new companies supplying the growing market for independent power.

"It can be much cheaper in rural and resort areas to install a wind and solar power system than to connect to the power grid," says Rolf Heckmann. "The upfront costs are lower and the savings over time are substantial."

That's what the staff of Prince Albert National Park discovered when they installed a 5 kW solar system at their remote Narrows Campground. Costs for running their aging, propane-fueled electrical generator were prohibitive and it was too expensive to run lines from the provincial power grid 20km away.

The park considered closing the campground to save costs. Instead, they contracted Kelln Solar to design a solar power system. Now operating costs are down, 70 tonnes of greenhouse gas emissions are saved annually, and the campground is a renewable energy demonstration site.

A small but growing number of homes, farms, cottages and businesses in Saskatchewan are finding

that independent energy systems can offer an option to utility power. It is expected that independent power generation could become a small but not insignificant part of the province's energy mix in the future.

So far, the most common application of solar power is in livestock production. Thousands of producers use it to pump water for cattle in pastures when it is too expensive to connect to the electrical grid. Solar power is also used by the provincial highways department and utilities to supply small amounts of power in remote areas, for applications such as signage.

Installing a simple solar system, with a solar panel and a storage battery to power a few lights, a radio and a small water pump for a cabin, can cost as little as \$1,000. Supplying a hybrid solar-wind power system adequate to supply power for a modern home will cost anywhere between \$20,000 to \$60,000 or even more depending on the system installed and the performance required from the system. Cost recovery is often achieved over several years by avoiding monthly power bills.

Independent producers also use solar and wind systems to supplement power supplied from the grid, and in some cases sell power to the utility. SaskPower formed its first small producer agreement with the Carnduff company Fast Trucking in 1999. Fast Trucking produces electricity from a 60 kW wind turbine, with excess power fed into the grid. One advantage of a grid-connected system is that expensive battery storage is not required, since the grid acts as a "virtual battery."

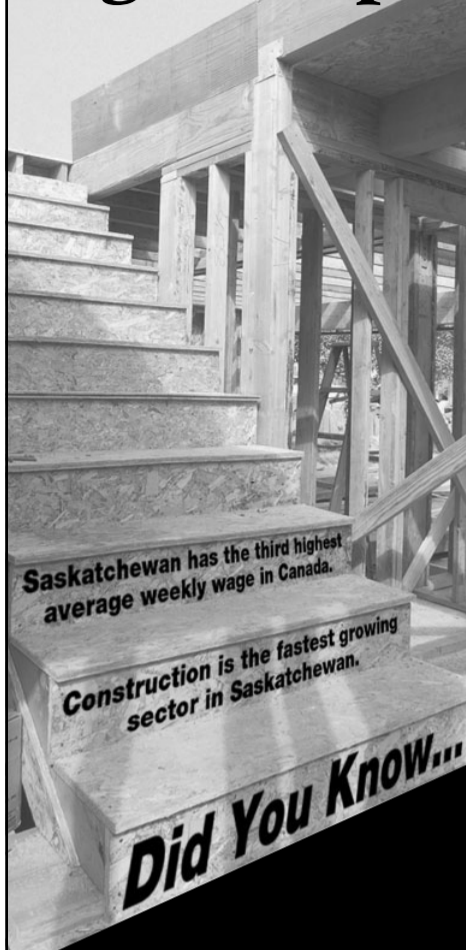
