In praise of P3's for economic development

Do you remember hearing the phrase, "Canada's distinct society"? It's a heavily used expression that has been uttered by various prime ministers and national governments, especially during the heated days of the failed Meech Lake Accord, or any time there is a renewed debate around the role of Quebec in Canada. But as Robert Shepherd, a former columnist with the Globe and Mail used to say, perhaps the real "distinct society" in Canada is not Quebec, but our own province of Saskatchewan.

Saskatchewan has given Canada many unique gifts – from Tommy Douglas, to John Diefenbaker, to Gordie Howe, to Brent Butt and Corner Gas. We are Canada's "hockey player factory." We have Canada's largest science project (the CLS synchrotron). We have been the global test-bed and pioneers of ATM banking machines, cobalt cancer therapy, integrated fibreoptic networks and zero-tillage farming. We have a unique wit, self-defacing humour, and small-town friendliness combined with strong global awareness and cosmopolitan sophistication. We constantly set national records in volunteerism, philanthropy and the spirited hosting of numerous big events. And what can be more unique than Rider Pride?

As president and CEO, I would be remiss if I did not point out another unique, Saskatchewan "FIRST", namely the Saskatchewan Trade and Export Partnership. The way in which Saskatchewan has chosen to deliver trade development and export services through STEP is yet one more reason why we also deserve to be called Canada's "other distinct society."

In return, business forms a partnership with the government through individual membership contributions and some extra user fees to also help sustain and direct STEP. Every day the staff and leadership of STEP are aware of the importance of "earning our keep" within this powerful and unique structure. Also, like any other enterprising business, STEP creatively works on the international stage to source other revenues, and deliver other valued services through constant innovation.

This strong orientation to direct customer service and accountability now permeates everything STEP does. It leads to laser-like focus, clearly defined metrics and a relentless attention to quality. Our board of directors has become a "who's who" of the top business leaders in Saskatchewan – representing every economic sector and region – and from emerging "young lions" to grizzled exporting veterans.

STEP now stands 400 members strong. In our last customer satisfaction survey, 97 per cent of our customers said they would recommend STEP to another exporter. Most of all, through a P3 approach to economic development, we drop the patronizing and paternalistic term, "stake-holder," that is all-too-often used in government bureaucracies. Business becomes a true partner and colleague through a working collaborative of common interests for the longer term good of the province, well beyond any four-year political cycle. It is no longer "us" (in government) doing it to "them" (in business) or doing things for "them." It is the power of WE.
